« Martin Jakob handles the ordinary. His work transforms and shifts the everyday in a play of matter, form and balance.

« This also applies to one of the classic questions of sculpture: the relationship between space, pedestal and figure. Jakob exaggerates the pedestal, constricts the movement in space - an elementary component of the perception of sculptures - to an extreme and thus leads the pedestal ad absurdum. According to him, this also applies to the landscape configuration that can be seen on the pedestal. He could reuse the material, especially the loose plaster, at any time. The material rigidity that characterises the sculpture dissolves into the ephemeral. The whole thing could be transformed. »

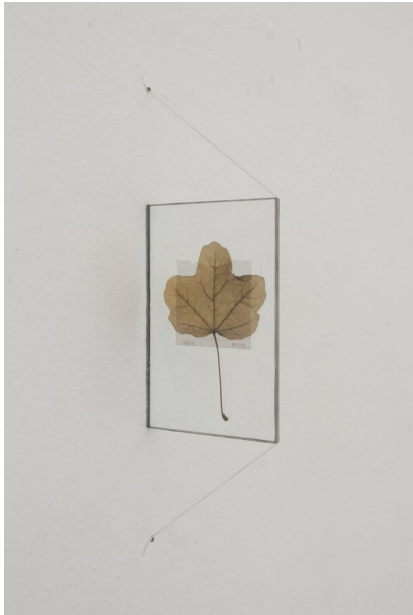

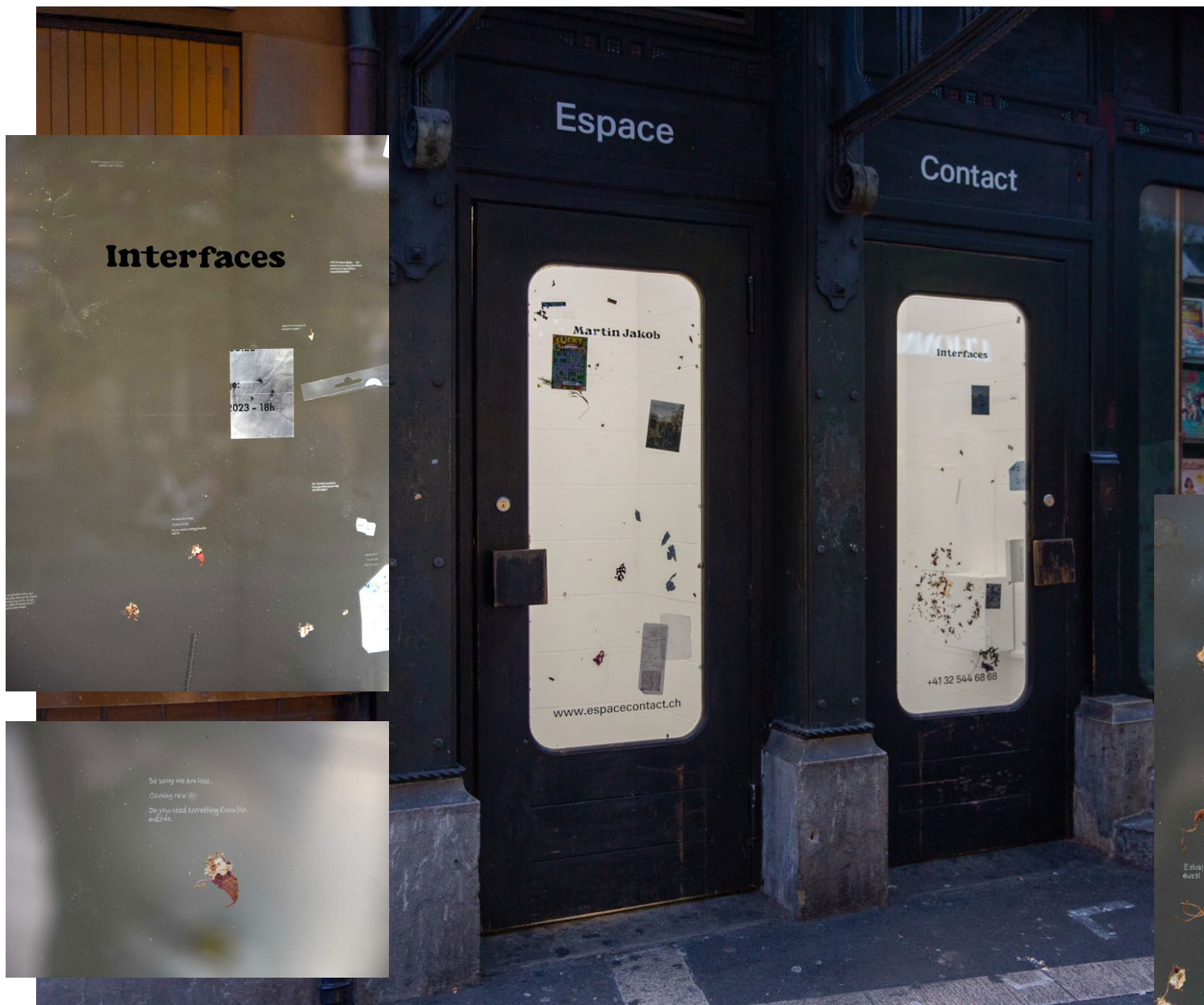

The installation is composed of furniture elements that take place in the courtyard of the School. This furniture allows to welcome the students during the breaks and captures the traces left by the users and by the weather conditions.

The flat surface of the furniture was, at the time of their installation, left in raw wood, untreated. For three years this surface will be marked by the wear and tear of daily life. Food stains, clothing rubbing and pen marks are superimposed with deliberate interventions such as graffiti, drawings, slogans, engravings and other inscriptions, as well as with the corrosion caused by natural elements, such as rain and sun. At the end of this period, a layer of varnish will be applied on the surface to interrupt the degradation process of the wood.

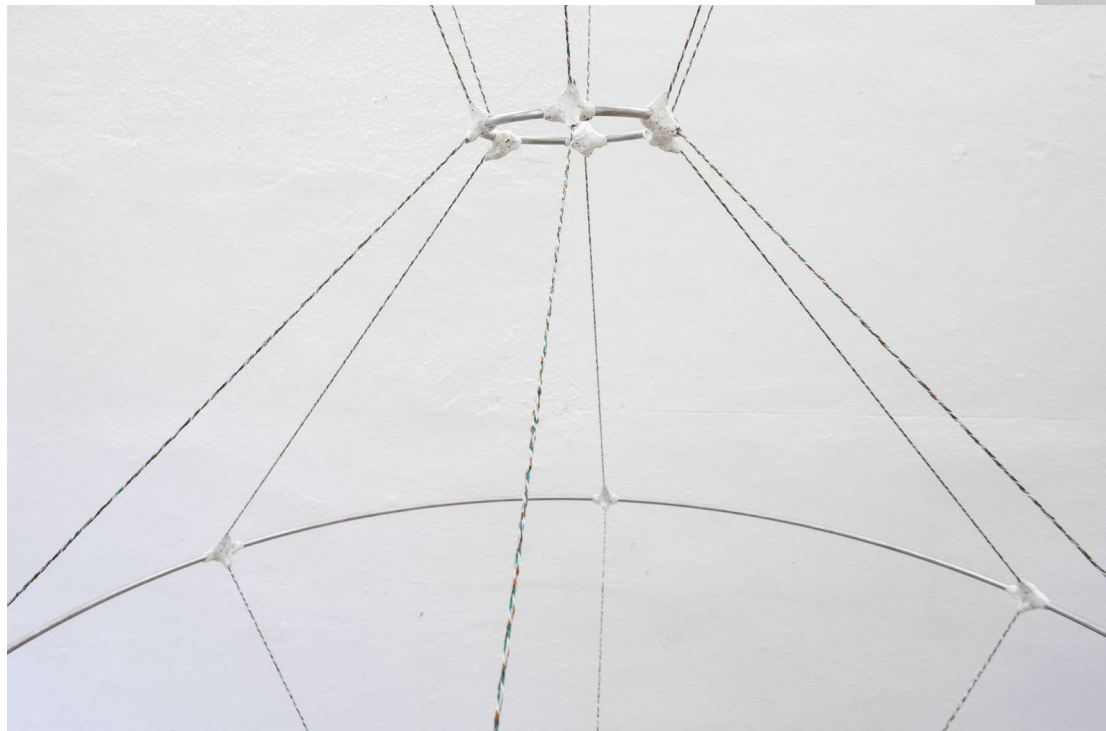

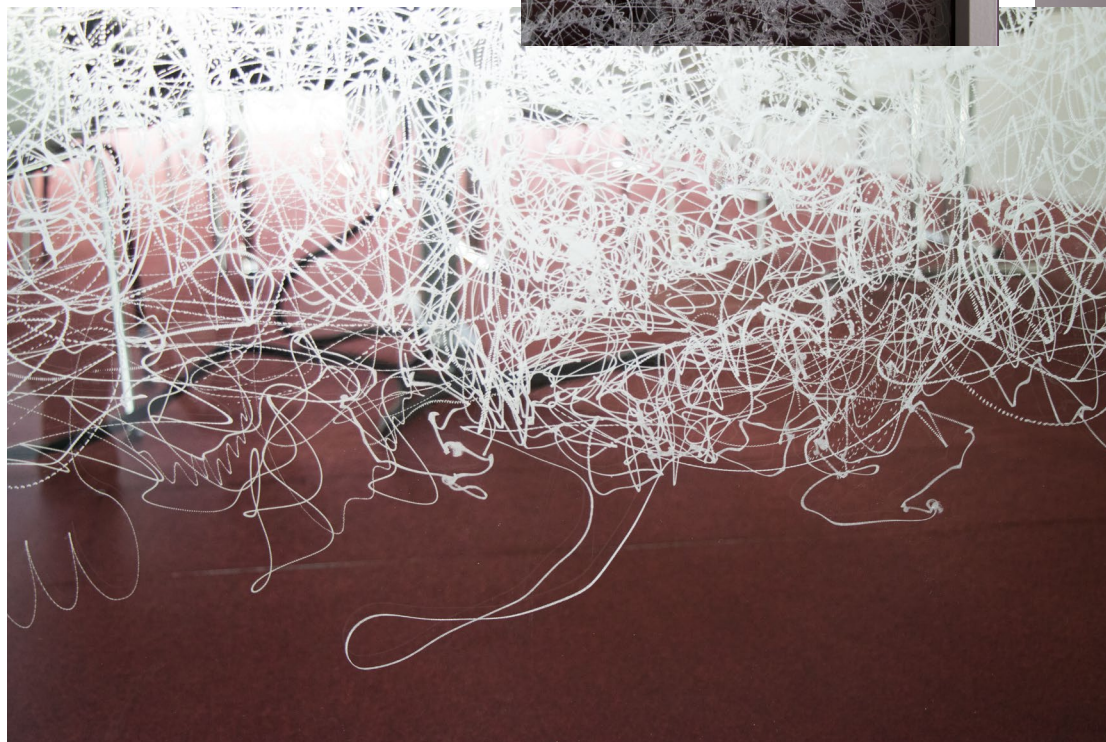


PAR NUÉES, 2020

This intervention is conceived for the glass walls of the CPLN polyvalent room. It opacifies the glass but allows light to pass through.

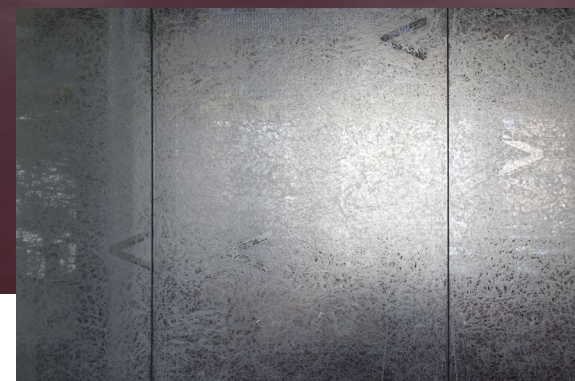

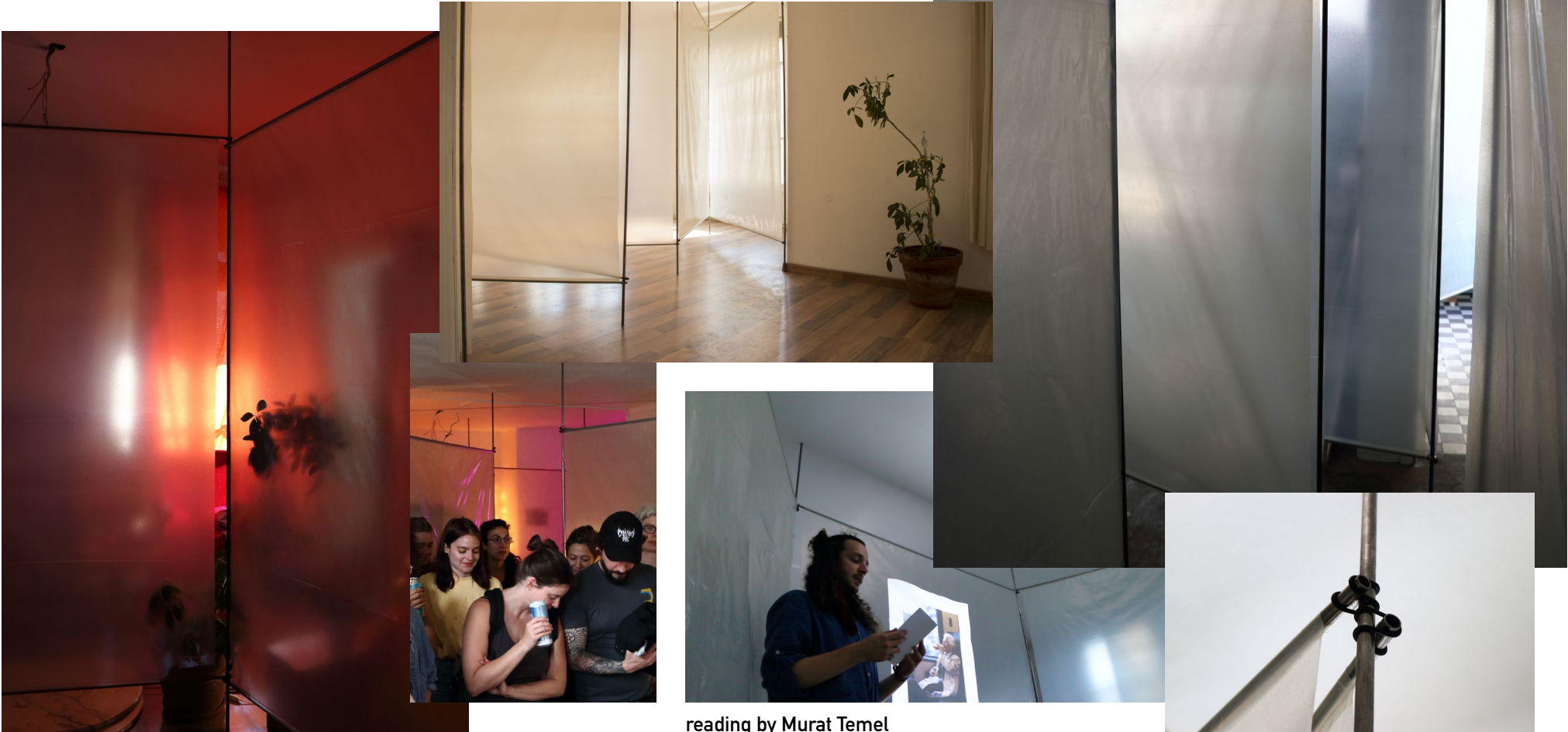
PISSER SUR LES BRAISES, 2018

Urgent Paradise, Lausanne CH

For Urgent Paradise's last exhibition at the Rue Dr César-Roux, Lausanne, Martin Jakob created a modular structure made of steel tubes and plastic sheeting. These translucent walls were moved several times during the exhibition. They restructured the spaces, closing off certain areas and revealing others, until they completely folded in on themselves on the last open day. The exhibition was punctuated by a number of events, including a meal, a concert by Save my Skin Music Lab, a reading by Murat Temel, a free shop and performances by Chienne de Garde, Cléa Chopard and Anne-Valérie Zuber.

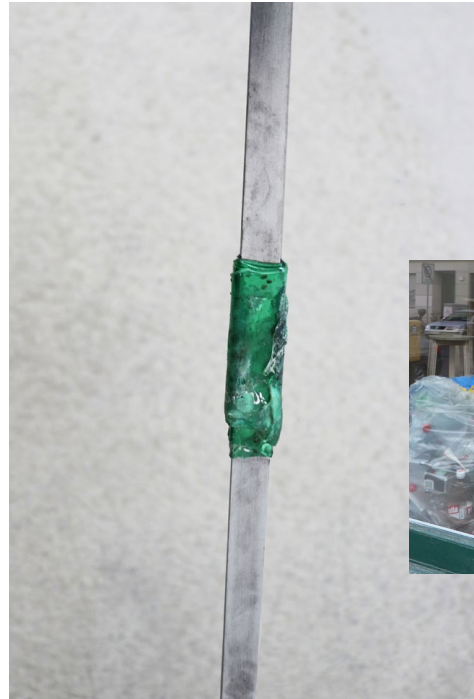
